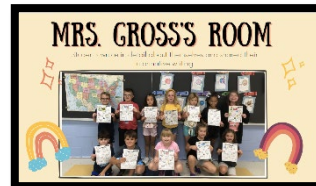

Greetings to our parents and guardians,

We are off to a good start this school year. I would like to introduce one of our new initiatives to support our students at RESN.

Our first initiative is what we call "All Hands-on Deck." During this thirty-minute block, students will receive intervention/enrichment to improve the skills necessary to be a fluid reader. Students will be placed in groups according to their beginning of the year DIBELS benchmark scores. Students will receive instruction from one of the "All Hands-on Deck" teaching team members, which includes homeroom teachers, reading specialists, special education teachers, and itinerant teachers. All students will be participating during this block and will not be missing any core instructional time.

The school goal is to have all students improve their reading fluency, accuracy, and comprehension.

In the upcoming weeks, I will share more with you about all the exciting things we are doing here at RESN.
