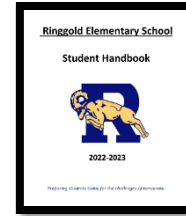

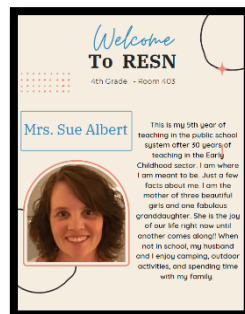

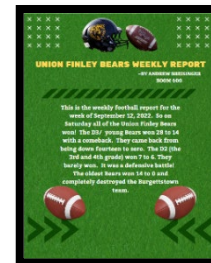

Dear Parents and Guardians,

As mentioned last week, we are introducing a couple of new initiatives this year. Our second initiative is what we like to call "Genius hour." This hour block is dedicated to hands-on learning for students through science known as Project Lead the Way. Each grade level will have hands-on learning experiences with science topics such as, Living Things, Animal Adaptations, Life Cycles, and Energy. In conjunction with the hands-on learning in the classroom, students will experience hands-on learning through their technology classes through design and coding.

Our students continue to demonstrate The Leader in Me habits by building their skills of vision, commitment, and purpose. Habit 2 of highly effective students is Begin With the End in Mind.
